Rev. Brian Konkol recently completed a term of service in South Africa as Country Coordinator of the Young Adults in Global Mission (YAGM) program of the ELCA Global Mission. In addition to his duties facilitating YAGM operations, Konkol assisted with parish ministry alongside isiZulu speaking congregations of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Southern Africa, lectured at the Lutheran Theological Institute, and functioned in ecumenical campus ministry at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. Konkol, who is originally

from Amherst Junction, WI, graduated from Viterbo University (La Crosse, WI), completed a Master of Divinity from Luther Seminary (St. Paul, MN), was ordained with the ELCA in 2005, and recently completed a Master of Theology degree from the University of KwaZulu-Natal (Pietermaritzburg, South Africa).

Rev. Konkol will facilitate Bible Study discussions throughout the weekend and will offer a keynote address surrounding topics of diversity, connectedness, and solidarity in God's mission.

Accommodations

Each cabin has its own rest room with shower. Campground campers have access to a central bathhouse.

To maximize housing space in anticipation of a full camp, adults may sleep in upper bunks. Families may also be housed in cabins with other families.

Registration & Fees

Guests are welcome to register and attend the full event or attend as a commuter.

Youth 6-12th grade youth may register as a Youth Camper and be housed with other youth and a college-aged camp counselor. Registration fee \$190/youth.

Adults Housing for adults registering as individuals will be in cabins with other adults divided by gender. Registration fee \$225/adult.

Families Families may register and be housed together as a group. Registration fees \$225/adult, \$190/youth, \$80/child.

Campground Bring your own tent/RV. A limited number of tent/RV sites available. Registration fees \$155/adult, \$120/youth, \$65/child. Electric hookup \$20/site.

Full Commuter Includes event, camp activities & meals for 4 day event. Registration fee \$100/adult.

Day Visitor Includes event, Bible Study, Worship, workshops, camp activities, lunch, dinner on Sunday and/or Monday. Registration fee \$50/person/day.

See registration form or website for full information on fees. Children 0-2 free. Register with non-refundable deposit of \$100 or total fee, whichever is less. Commuters are welcome to arrive anytime after 9am each day and are encouraged to pre-register.
